### Sequence of Conflicts

#### Northern Ireland

- **1922:** Six Irish counties vote to remain in United Kingdom.
- **After 1922:** Minority Catholics demand civil rights and unification with the south.
- **1960s:** Extremists on both sides turn to violence.
- **1998:** Good Friday Agreement (peace accord) is signed.

#### Chechnya

- **Mid-1990s:** Separatists in Chechnya try to break away from Russia.
- **Late 1990s:** Russia crushes Chechen revolt.
- **Early to mid-2000s:** Some Chechens turn to terrorism in other parts of Russia.

#### Yugoslavia

- **Before 1991:** Yugoslavia is multiethnic.
- **1991:** Slovenia and Croatia declare independence. Fighting breaks out between Serbs and Croats in Croatia.
- **1992:** Bosnia declares independence.
- **1992:** Ethnic conflict spreads to Bosnia.
- **1992:** Bosnian Serbs institute policy of ethnic cleansing.
- **1995:** Dayton Accords (peace treaty) are signed.
- **Mid-1990s:** Ethnic Albanians fight against Serbs in Kosovo.
- **1999:** NATO forces Yugoslav troops to withdraw from Kosovo.
- **Mid-2000s:** Kosovo moves toward independence.
- **2006:** Montenegro breaks away from Serbia.
